Newborn Screening Cards with CCHD Screening Results Page– Available Now!

Newborn screening cards with the CCHD screening results page attached are available for order through VWR using the regular [ordering procedure](#) for newborn screening cards. More details on the CCHD screening results page can be found in the [CCHD documentation and follow-up presentation](#).


If you are ALREADY SCREENING for CCHD and will be submitting results to NSO

- If you are a Phase 1 site, you may continue to use your remaining cards with inserted CCHD screening results page. Only order new cards when you need them.
- You may detach the CCHD screening page from the rest of the newborn screening card if necessary for your screening workflow.
- Fully complete the [CCHD screening page](#). Always label or fill out the demographics portion of this CCHD screening page, even if it remains attached to the rest of the newborn screening card.
- If the blood spot sample is a repeat test, it is not necessary to repeat the CCHD screen. In this case, please leave the CCHD screening page blank and attached to the newborn screening card.
- Ship the CCHD screening page to NSO with the rest of the newborn screening card or separately if it has been detached. The two pieces need not travel together.

If you are NOT YET SCREENING for CCHD

- The next time you order newborn screening cards they will have the CCHD results sheet attached as part of the card, even if you are not yet screening. Please leave the CCHD results sheet blank and attached to the newborn screening card when you send it to us, until you begin screening.
- Please let us know your plans to start screening for CCHD by pulse oximetry so we can support you in your transition to screening and provide resources to assist you, by completing our [online form](#). All hospitals and midwifery practice groups are expected to be screening by the end of 2017.
